

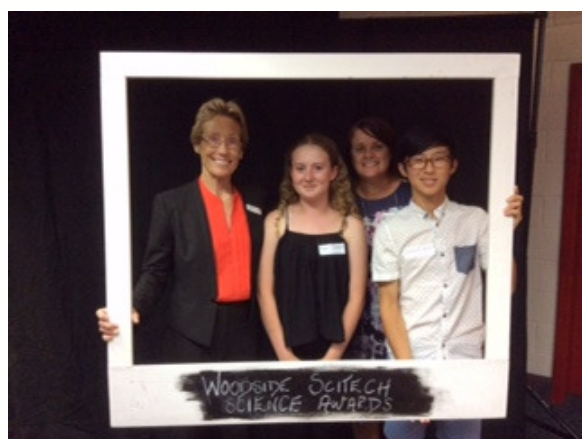
# Newsletter
